

BOOKING INFORMATION

Our program caters for children from Reception to Year 6. We aim to provide a safe, stimulating environment for the children to enjoy their school holidays. OPERATING HOURS

The program operates between 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Friday. You may drop off or pick up your children anytime between these hours. Please ring us as soon as possible and us if you are unable to collect your children. A fee of \$15 per child, per 15 minutes will apply for late collection

Remember to sign your children in and out each day.

PROGRAM

A range of activities will be offered during the day including craft, board games, sports, playground, plus our main morning and afternoon activities. The program will be displayed on the notice board. Due to weather the program is subject to change without notice. Fees will be adjusted accordingly

EDUCATORS

We operate on a ratio of 1 staff member to 15 children and lower ratios on excursions.

BOOKINGS

We have a new booking system called Xplor. You are able to book directly through the Xplor Home App on your phone. Please contact us if you are having trouble.

CANCELLATIONS

Once your booking has been confirmed, all cancellations will incur the daily fee.

PAYMENTS

\$55 per child per day, plus extra for excursions or special activities as indicated. All accounts to be paid via the Xplor Home App. Please note, you will be charged for non-attended days booked.

CHILD CARE SUBSIDY (CCS)

LUNCHES

<u>Please send your child with an adequate packed recess, lunch and a drink each day unless otherwise indicated on the program</u>. A snack is provided each day for afternoon tea as part of the program. There is water available to refill water bottles. Lunch orders are available from the café.

We have a Nut Aware Policy. No nuts are to be brought into the vacation care nor will they be used in any activities. All external providers are made aware that we are Nut Aware.

CLOTHING & BELONGINGS

The children must bring a hat every day. Please ensure all items of clothing and belongings are named. Appropriate clothing should be worn according to the program. No singlets or short shorts (due to sun safety). A hat and sunscreen must be worn for all outdoor activities. Educators are not responsible for accidents or loss of property in connection with any child's participation.

CORONAVIRUS OR COVID-19

To reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19 please do not attend if your child is feeling sick, displaying symptoms of or have been in close contact with a person who has COVID-19.

IF YOUR CHILD TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 YOU MUST NOTIFY THE REX VACATION CARE. PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND FOR 5 DAYS IF COVID-19 POSITIVE. DO NOT ATTEND WHILE SYMPTOMATIC
